Tips for Drivers, Pedestrians, and Cyclists to maintain safe travels in the Village of La Grange

<p>Obey Posted Speed Limits Be mindful of weather conditions, areas of pedestrian traffic, and school zones)</p> <p>Reduce distractions in vehicles: Use hands-free devices Lower radio volume</p> <p>Yield to ALL pedestrians (crosswalks or otherwise)</p> <p>Make eye contact and use hand signals to communicate with pedestrians and cyclists</p> <p>Share the roadway with cyclists</p>	<p>Use crosswalks (even if they are further down the street from where you intend to cross)</p> <p>If out for a leisurely walk or exercise, wear reflective or contrasting colors</p> <p>Do not assume a vehicle sees you or your children</p> <p>Make eye contact and use hand signals to communicate with a vehicle's driver</p> <p>Do not be distracted by cellphones or other devices while walking</p> <p>Obey WALK/DO NOT WALK signage</p>	<p>Stop at red lights and obey stop signs</p> <p>Travel with the flow of traffic</p> <p>Wear reflective or contrasting colors</p> <p>Travel at safe speeds</p> <p>Do not assume right of way at intersections</p> <p>Signal turns and lane changes</p> <p>Make eye contact and use hand signals to indicate your intentions</p> <p>All cyclists are required to follow the same rules of the road as motorists</p>
